





ORDER OF COMMENDATION REGARDING
THE SERVICE OF DOTTIE CLEVENGER

Dottie Clevenger, Data Quality Analyst for the United States Bankruptcy Clerk's Office in the Southern District of Indiana, is retiring as an employee of the Bankruptcy Clerk on September 30, 2012, after 24 years of service to the Federal Courts in the Southern District of Indiana.

Dottie's official title does not capture the many roles she has played during her career, all of which have involved public service of the highest order: supervising the intake counter and handling customer inquiries; coordinating registration for ECF accounts; and training new ECF users.
